

Jeffrey W. Wadelin is presently Associate Executive Director for the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE). He received a B.S. in Pharmacy from Ohio Northern University in 1981, and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Pharmaceutical Administration from The Ohio State University in 1982 and 1986, respectively. He was originally licensed pharmacist in the State of Ohio in 1981 (license presently inactive). Dr. Wadelin has been in his present position at ACPE since July 1989. Prior to joining ACPE, he was Assistant Professor of Pharmacy Administration at The University of Toledo College of Pharmacy, receiving his appointment in March 1985.
