Dr. Bright is an Assistant Professor of Pharmacy Practice at the Ohio Northern University (ONU). He received his PharmD degree from the University of Toledo (UT) and subsequently completed a community pharmacy residency with Kroger Pharmacy and UT. While at ONU, he helped to develop and served as a clinical pharmacist and as the director of ONU HealthWise, a multidisciplinary worksite wellness and disease state management program.
